CROCHET CHEAT SHEET

Basic Crochet Stitches - US Terms

SLIP STITCH - SL ST

Insert hook into stitch, YO, pull through stitch and loop on hook.

CHAIN - CH

Make slip knot, YO, pull through loop on hook.

SINGLE CROCHET - SC

Insert hook into stitch, YO, pull up a loop (2 loops on hook), YO, pull through both loops.

HALF DOUBLE CROCHET - HDC

YO, insert hook into stitch, YO, pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), YO, pull through all 3 loops.

DOUBLE CROCHET - DC

YO, insert hook into stitch, YO, pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), YO, pull through 2 loops, YO, pull through last 2 loops.

TREBLE CROCHET - TR

YO twice, insert hook into stitch, YO, pull up a loop (4 loops on hook), * YO, pull through 2 loops - repeat from * 3 more times.

MAGIC RING / MAGIC CIRCLE (MR / MC)

- Wrap yarn around two fingers to make a loop.
- Insert hook under the front loop, YO, pull up a loop, ch 1 (or required chains).
- Work stitches into the loop. Pull tail to close the ring

TURNING CHAINS (TC)

Turning chains are the chains you make at the start of a new row so your yarn reaches the height of the next row's stitches. The number of turning chains depends on the stitch.

- single crochet (sc) chain 1
- half double crochet (hdc) chain 2
- double crochet (dc) chain 3
- treble crochet (tr) chain 4
