Use this chart to find the right head circumference and height for babies, kids, teens, and adults when crocheting hats.

QUICK TIPS FOR CROCHET HATS

- Measure first: Always check head circumference before starting.
- If the pattern starts at the crown, start with a magic ring: Ensures a tight, gap-free top.
- Use stitch markers: Keep track of rounds and increases.
- Increase evenly: Spread increases in early rounds for a smooth shape.
- Check gauge: Match your swatch to pattern gauge for proper fit.
- Try on as you go: Especially for fitted hats.
- Choose the right yarn: Softer yarns for baby hats, sturdier for adults.
- Adjust height: Add or reduce rounds to fit the wearer's head.
- Finish edges neatly: Slip stitch or crab stitch for a polished look.
- Weave in ends securely: Prevent unraveling, especially in ribbed or textured hats.
